**Directions to: Abbot's Hill HP3 8RP**

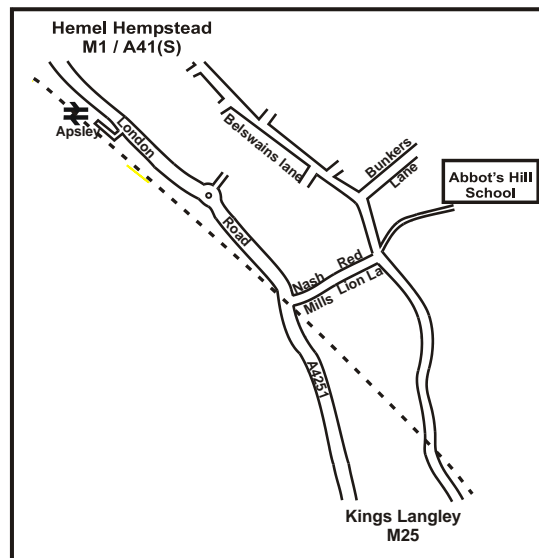
From the M1 J8, take the A414 (dual carriageway) across 4 roundabouts downhill to the 'Magic Roundabout', take 1st exit on left, Lawn Lane, cross over a set of traffic lights. At roundabout turn right into Belswains Lane. After approx 1.2 miles (across 3 more roundabouts) the School is on the left, immediately after Bunkers Lane.

From M25 J20 take A4251 through Kings Langley, at traffic lights under railway bridge, turn right into Nash Mills Lane/Red Lion Lane. Entrance to Abbot's Hill School is virtually directly opposite end of road across roundabout.

The car park is immediately on entering the school grounds at the top of the drive and also to the left. The school sports & drama centre is on the far right of the school estate & will be sign-posted.

The nearest train station is Apsley (direct from London Euston every ½ hr). This station is just over a mile from Abbot's Hill. There are taxi ranks at Hemel Hempstead station next stop with more frequent trains or Kings Langley (previous stop).

NB If you arrive after the main arrival time and the school gates are closed, please use back entrance in Bunkers Lane.

## Classes Available:

**Please** be realistic in assessing which classes are suitable, in order that everyone can get the most out of the day. If in doubt, please ask!

### Elementary Class:

- For dancers who are new to, or have started dancing within the last year or so.

### Intermediate Class for dancers:

- who have been dancing for approximately 1 to 3 years.
- who are able to do the correct steps when doing step practice even if unable to maintain during the dances
- who usually go the correct way in reels of 3.
- who know the common formations.

### Advanced Class for dancers who are:

- Able to dance correctly with good technique
- Able to learn a new dance quickly
- Able to help others whilst dancing
- Able to demonstrate sound knowledge of the majority of formations and links.

Footwear! Abbots Hill have requested that only soft soled dance shoes are worn, especially in the Dance Studio (Elementary Class). If you have a problem with this, please contact us beforehand.

David & Avril Quarrie will jointly teach two classes for advanced dancers and one for intermediate.
